GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **CATEGORIES:** The following Categories are to be held:
 - CanSkate Elements Event (Stage 1-6)
 - Academy Spin, Spiral, Jump Creative Level 1 Event
 - Academy TEAM Event
 - Star 1 Freeskate Event
 - Star 2 Freeskate Event
 - Star 1-2 TEAM Events
2. **ENTRY FEES:**
 - CanSkate Elements Event: \$25.00
 - Academy Spin, Spiral, Jump Creative Level 1: \$50.00
 - Star 1-2 Freeskate Events: \$65.00
 - TEAM EVENT Academy + STAR 1 & 2: \$40.00 / Team
3. **EVENT SCHEDULE:** A schedule will be emailed to all participants once the schedule is finalized.
4. **ENTRIES:** Entrants in Events shall be:
 - a. Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100
 - b. Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. All event entries will be accepted only from skaters who are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.
5. **CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES:** All entries must be registered online no later than midnight on **November 15, 2022**. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date.
6. **LATE ENTRIES:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Committee and if space permits in the event.
7. **REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:** ***NO refunds will be made after the closing date.*** Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held.
8. **ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Skaters must register at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled Category or practice. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain 30 minutes prior to their scheduled Category. All music will be played by iPod. Out-of-club skaters shall submit their program music in MP3 format via email to the Competition Chair (competition@okotoksskatingclub.ca) no later than Monday November 21.
9. **SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability.
10. **WARM UP TIMES:** Skate Canada has standardized warm up times for all events. Warm up times for all CanSkate events will be 3 minutes.
11. **AWARDS:** Medals and certificates will be presented on-site at the event.

12. **ACCIDENTS:** The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

CANSKATE ELEMENT EVENT

The CanSkate Element Event gives skaters the opportunity to showcase their skills in a fun and interactive environment. The focus of the event is on individual skill improvement and therefore performances are not ranked, rather awards are based on performance standards alone. The participants execute elements according to their categories.

*Note that skills are integrated - if a skater has passed Stage 1, they would enter in Stage 2. Coaches will organize skaters into their appropriate Categories.

Stage 1:

- Snow Slide Steps
- Fwd Push/Glide Sequence
- 2 ft Jump
- Bwd 2 ft Skating/walking

Stage 2:

- Fwd Stop
- Fwd 2 ft Sculling
- Fwd 2 ft Turn (CW or CCW – skater's choice)
- Bwd 2 ft Sit Glide

Stage 3:

- Fwd Circle Thrusts (CW or CCW – skater's choice) Bwd 2 ft Jump
- 2 ft Quick Turn Fwd – Bwd and Bwd – Fwd (CW or CCW – skater's choice)
- Bwd 2 ft Sculling

Stage 4:

- Bwd Circle Thrusts (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- Bwd 360 degree Step Turn (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- 2 ft Jump Fwd – Bwd and Bwd – Fwd (CW or CCW - Skater's choice)
- Fwd Inside Slalom

Stage 5:

- Fwd 2-ft Side Stop (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- Bwd Push/Glide Sequence, Full Perimeter (CW or CCW - Skater's choice)
- Fwd Power Jump
- Fwd Crosscuts - Figure-8

Stage 6:

- Fwd 1-ft Side Stop (L or R - skater's choice)
- Bwd Perimeter Skating with Crosscuts (CW or CCW - determined by draw)
- Fwd 180° Step Turn (C-Step) (RFI-LBI or LFI-RBI - Skater's choice)
- Fwd Outside Edges

ACADEMY SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP CREATIVE EVENT

- Creative Expression Routine
