- 3. **EVENT SCHEDULE**: The schedule will be posted and sent to all participants once finalized.
- 4. **ENTRIES:** Be registrants of Skate Canada in good standing.
- 5. <u>CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES</u>: All entries must be registered online no later than midnight on *November 16, 2023.* It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date.
- 6. **LATE ENTRIES**: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Committee and if space permits.
- 7. <u>**REFUND OF ENTRY FEES</u>**: *NO refunds will be made after the closing date.* Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held.</u>

STAR 2 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 2 Freeskate programs.

Planned program content and music MUST be submitted at the time of registration.

STAR 3 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained Star 3 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 3 Freeskate programs.
