## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. **CATEGORIES**: The following Categories are to be held:

Showcase - Star 1 - Spin Spiral Jump Event

Star 1 Elements Event

Star 2 & 3 Freeskate Program Events

Star 2-3 TEAM Events

#### 2. ENTRY FEES:

Showcase - Star 1 - Spin Spiral Jump Event: \$65.00

Star 1 Elements Event: \$80.00

Star 2 & 3 Freeskate Program Events: \$80.00

Star 2-3 TEAM Events: \$55.00 / Team

- 3. PROGRAM MUSIC SUBMISSION: Music must be submitted in MP3 format at the time of registration. All files will be reviewed, and the Host Committee will contact skaters if any issues are identified. For event playback, music will be uploaded to an iPod device; however, skaters are still required to bring a backup copy of their music on a Bluetooth-enabled device. It is the responsibility of each skater to ensure the correct file is provided. The Host Committee cannot be held responsible for errors if incorrect music is submitted.
- 4. <u>TEAM EVENT REGISTRATION</u>: Team event registration must be completed by one designated representative on behalf of the entire team. All team members must be listed at the time of registration, and full payment for the team is required upon submission. For detailed step-by-step guidance, please refer to the Team Event Registration Cheat Sheet available on our website.
- 5. **EVENT SCHEDULE**: The schedule will be posted and sent to all participants once finalized.
- 6. **ENTRIES:** Must be registrants of Skate Canada in good standing.
- 7. **CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES**: All entries must be registered online no later than midnight on **November 12, 2025.**
- 8. **LATE ENTRIES**: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Committee and if space permits.
- 9. **REFUND OF ENTRY FEES**: **NO refunds will be made after the closing date**. Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held.
- 10. **ON-SITE REGISTRATION**: Skaters must register at least 45-60 minutes prior to their scheduled category and must report to the Ice Captain 30 minutes prior to their scheduled event flight time.
- 11. **SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability.
- 12. WARM UP TIMES: Skate Canada has standardized warm up times for all events.
- 13. AWARDS: Ribbons and award sheets will be presented on-site at the event.

14. ACCIDENTS: The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

## STARSKATE FREESKATE EVENTS

#### <u>SHOWCASE – STAR 1 – SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP EVENT</u>

Designed for skaters who do not yet have a freeskate program. Skaters will perform a program on full ice to music of their choice (submitted at the time of registration). Music must be 1 minute in length (maximum 1:00) and should include a minimum of one jump, one spin, and one spiral.

- Minimum of one jump waltz jump, toe loop or salchow.
- Minimum of one spin forward or backward upright spin.
- Minimum of one spiral forward spiral on either edge.

Assessed on program components and skating skills as outlined in the Skate Canada - STAR 1-4 and Special Olympics for Events Standards for Assessment Guide.

#### **STAR 1 ELEMENTS**

Skaters will perform the following skills and will be assessed accordingly. Skaters are permitted to have their coaches nearby, either at rink side or on the ice, to provide support and help build their confidence during the performance.

- Circle Stroking
- Waltz Jump
- Salchow Jump
- Toe Loop Jump
- Forward Upright Spin
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Circles

  Creative expression routine (30 seconds music provided by the host of

Creative expression routine (30 seconds - music provided by the host club, selection randomly chosen at competition): this is assessed as "complete" or "incomplete" only.

#### **STAR 2 FREESKATE PROGRAM**

Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 2 Freeskate programs.

Program music must be submitted at the time of registration.

#### **STAR 3 FREESKATE PROGRAM**

Skaters will perform their trained Star 3 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 3 Freeskate programs.

Program and program music must be submitted at the time of registration.

## STARSKATE TEAM EVENTS

Team Events are an opportunity for groups of up to four skaters (and minimum of two skaters) to perform together in a fun atmosphere.

Skaters will each perform at least one Freeskate element and will contribute to an overall team assessment. Elements will be performed in the order listed. Each element may only be attempted once.

Team events will be assessed as outlined in the Skate Canada - STAR 1-4 and Special Olympics for Events Standards for Assessment Guide.

Please reach out to your skater's coach for assistance in finding a team to join, if interested.
